TO: Jeff Pomerleau, Constable of the Town of Greenville, in the County of Piscataquis and in the State of Maine.

GREETINGS:

In the name of the State of Maine, you are hereby required to notify and warn the inhabitants of the Town of Greenville in said county and state, qualified by law to vote in Town affairs, to assemble at the Meeting Hall of the Municipal Building located at 7 Minden Street in Greenville on **Wednesday, May 7, 2008 at 6:00 PM** to act on the following articles, to wit:

ARTICLE 1: To elect, by ballot, a moderator to preside at said meeting.

ARTICLE 2: To see if the voters of the Town of Greenville will appropriate and authorize a majority of the municipal officers of the Town to expend a principal amount not to exceed \$884,000 for the purpose of reconstructing the Junction Wharf, a parcel of Town-owned property located in Greenville Junction on the West Cove of Moosehead Lake (Tax Map 24, Lot Number 36) (the "Project") and for that purpose to accept, appropriate and expend on the Project state, federal and other grant funds and to borrow on behalf of the Town, a principal amount not to exceed **\$250,000** through the issuance of general obligation bonds or notes of the Town of Greenville, which may be callable bonds or notes, and further to authorize the municipal officers to do any and all things and execute any and all contracts or documents necessary or convenient to issue the bonds or notes of the Town and construct the Project.
