7. **Airport Projects and Hangar Development:** A letter should go to the hangar lessees who have until the end of this construction season to complete construction of their hangars or risk losing their lots. Several hangar lessees have expressed concern that either (1) we will make exceptions to this requirement which would be unfair to those who will construct by the deadline, and (2) that the taxiway won't be paved any time soon. The FAA and MDOT are each prepared to fund their portions of the repaving of the crosswind runway in 2008. I suggest the Board affirm at this meeting that (1) no exceptions will be made, and (2) the Town is committed to repaving crosswind runway, a project which will include the paving of the taxiways on either side of the crosswind runway. I would forward this affirmation to the lessees in the form of a letter.
