1. Minutes of August 4 and 16, 2011

Motion by Richard to approve both sets of minutes. Motion seconded by Bruce and approved on 3-0 vote.

2. Additions or Deletions to the Agenda

Motion by Bruce to add the Pritham Avenue closing on Sept 10 discussion to tonight's agenda. Motion seconded by Richard and approved on 3-0 vote.

3. Public Comment Period - none

3A. Discussion with Action - whether to close Pritham Avenue on Saturday Sept 10 during Fly In weekend. Discussion ensued for several minutes with Board and business owners present. Concerns were raised about reduced on street parking and vendors being able to travel to and from their businesses. It was stated an officer would be at each barricade of the closed section of Pritham...and would allow Jamo's, Kamp Kamp or other owners or staff to come and go as necessary. Perhaps this would be a good idea next year if the craft fair was set up on Pritham Avenue.

Motion by Bruce to not close Pritham Avenue at all. Motion seconded by Richard and approved on 3-0 vote.

4. Discussion with Action - Set our tax rate for Fiscal Year 11/12 through June 30, 2012

Motion by Richard to set tax rate at \$12.00 per thousand. Motion seconded by Bruce and approved on 3-0 vote.

5. Discussion with Action - Vote whether to approve liquor license renewal and entertainment and dancing permit for Stress Free Moose restaurant at 65 Pritham Avenue.

Motion by Bruce to renew the liquor license only and not the entertainment and dancing permit. Motion seconded by Richard and approved on 3-0 vote.

6. Discussion with Action – Set selectmen's meeting of Tuesday Oct 4th for public hearing for dangerous building action on 21 Lower Lincoln Street property owned by Dan MacFadyen. Gary Lamb and CEO Jack Hart made brief introductory comments. Dan made no introductory comments.

Motion by Bruce to set 6pm on October 4 2011 as date for dangerous building public hearing. Motion seconded by Richard and approved on 3-0 vote.

A short discussion then ensued between Mr. MacFadyen, staff and the Board.
