In particular, the candidates will be asked to identify from this list the three most important issues they feel are facing our community, and to speak to how they will help improve these three matters for the benefit of the Town of Greenville directly and indirectly the entire region.

Following these presentations, the Selectmen may have some brief additional questions for the candidates. The candidates are invited at any time to ask questions of the Selectmen or the Town Manager.
