

Minutes of Greenville Board of Selectmen Meeting

1. Minutes of October 24, 2012

- Motion by Bruce Wyman to approve minutes as presented. Motion seconded by Craig and motion approved on 4-0 vote

2. Addition or Deletions to the Agenda - none

3. Public Comment period - none

4. Discussion with Action - short presentation/discussion with Ken Woodbury re: grant application for multi-use trail construction. Vote whether to approve Ken's submission of a Recreational Trail Development Grant for construction of the Moosehead Snowmobile/ATV Connector Trail Project.

- Ken spoke briefly about the recreational and economic value of a multi-use trail around the lake for both sno sleds and ATV's...and that all parties have been working to establish a route from Greenville to Kokadjo. Plum Creek will soon decide if they will allow ATV traffic over their Wilson Stream bridge, KI road and land adjacent to the KI Road.
- Ken informed the Board that this grant will not require any town funds because ATV clubs will provide any matching funds needed
- Craig made the motion to approve the RTP grant application. Motion seconded by Bruce Wyman and approved on 4-0 vote.
- Bonnie suggested that once a tentative ATV route is chosen, the town should inform all residents along that route about this proposed activity.

5. Discussion only - Conversation with Michael Rayne, owner of 15 Preo Street residence, about Preo Park tree removal situation

- Mr. Rayne spoke briefly about the Preo Park trees that have not been removed by the town, and that he does not feel safe on his property because of them.
- Board discussion ensued around whether DPW could cut up and remove the brush and wood if an insured professional simply felled the trees. DPW foreman indicated yes.
- Motion made by Craig for town to work with Mr. Rayne for removal of the worst trees in Preo Park, and also for town manager to obtain estimates for Red Cross Beach entrance road tree removal. Motion seconded by Bruce Wyman and motion approved on 4-0 vote.

6. Town Manager's Report

- Lamb mentioned inviting the school board to the Dec 5th Bd Sel meeting to discuss whether we want any spring town wide vote and/or 2013 town meeting warrant article regarding Nickerson School demolition costs. Discussion ensued among Board members and audience members about recent School Building committee meetings and activity. Lamb will go ahead and invite school board to Dec 5th meeting and attempt to also attend the next Building committee meeting.

- Lamb also mentioned the June 14-16 2013 moose lottery and that he is going to the Nov 19th School Board meeting to discuss this event in general with the Board as to how school property will be used that weekend. Richard Peat and Bruce Wyman volunteered to be on the Moose Lottery weekend planning committee.
- Lamb reminded the Board and public of the Tuesday Nov 14th public hearing on ATV road usage

7. What's on your mind? - An opportunity for Selectmen to share questions, concerns, ideas or suggestions - informational only

- Selectmen stated the ATV club should come prepared Nov 14th to briefly present their case and answer questions as to their request. Craig stated he sees two separate ATV issues at hand...first is request for ATV use approval for all town roads...second is for route to Kokadjo. Bruce Wyman stated he is not in favor of ATV use for all side streets.
- Roxanne asked how far north on Lily Bay road are ATV's permitted now. The answer was up to Foss Street.
